### **Basketball News**


Practices have started and a schedule will be sent home this week with players.

### **Kindergarten Registration 2024-2025**

Parents are asked to register their child(ren) for Kindergarten prior to or during the week of November 20-24, 2023.

- Children must be 5 years old by December 31, 2024, in order to be eligible for Kindergarten.
- Parents are asked to register their child at the local elementary school during school hours. If you are unsure of your school zone, please call the Stratford Office at (902)368-6990 or Summerside Office at (902)888-8400 or toll-free at 1-800-280-7965.
- A registration form will be completed at the time of registration.
- Parents are reminded to bring a piece of Government issued ID veryifying proof of child's age, such as a birth certificate, PEI health card or passport.
- Verification of home address must also be provided, such as a current utility bill.
